About

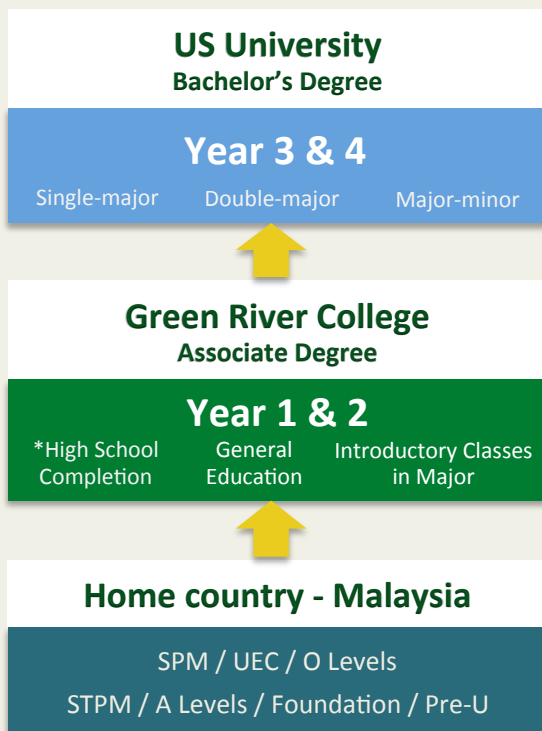
Founded in 1965, Green River College is a two-year public college in Washington State that offers more than 100 different degrees and certificates in academic and technical programs. The campus is located on 186 acres of tall trees in a park-like setting and is known for its safe, friendly and peaceful study environment. More than 9,000 students study at Green River, with over 1700 international students from 64 countries.

Green River is about 45 minutes from Seattle. Seattle maintains a strong economy driven by a mix of older industrial companies and new economy internet and technology companies, service, design and clean technology companies. It is the home to Microsoft, Boeing, Amazon.com and Starbucks Coffee. The largest airport in the area is Seattle-Tacoma International Airport.



University Transfer 2 + 2 years

Green River's 2+2 program allows students to take the first two years of their bachelor's degree at Green River and then transfer to one of over 4,700 universities in the US to complete their bachelor's degree. In order to obtain a bachelor's degree in the US, all students must complete specific requirements for their major as well as general education requirements which represent a foundation of learning in various areas including Math, Writing, Science, Social Science and Humanities. With their academic advisor at Green River, students develop an individual transfer plan that includes general education classes and introductory classes for their major. They are given freedom to select classes of their choice from general categories. Students earn an Associate Degree after two years at Green River.

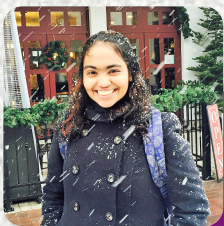
